DIG is a hands-on archaeological adventure, giving the children the chance to become trainee 'diggers' and discover exciting artefacts from 2,000 years of York's history, as well as taking part in a "Traders, Looters or Settlers?" workshop. After this, the class will take part in a full, interactive tour of Jorvik Viking Centre.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9am, and will return to school in time for the end of the school day. In the interests of safety, children should wear school uniform for the day. They will also need:

- A packed lunch and plenty to drink
- A raincoat

The cost of the trip will be £14.80 (£8.50 for entrance to DIG and Jorvik, and £6.30 for the coach).

Under the terms of the Education Reform Act 1996, the school is not allowed to make a charge for this activity but we are permitted to ask for voluntary contributions. No pupil will be discriminated against on the grounds of cost. However, if there are insufficient voluntary contributions towards this activity, then, unfortunately, it may have to be cancelled.
