Headteacher's Message

I have to begin by saying how incredibly proud we all are of our fantastic Year 6 children after a gruelling week of tests. They all worked as hard as possible and demonstrated maturity and resilience throughout the week. The results will be published in July, but we don't need these to inform us that each of them have different talents and skills and are a group of fantastic young people. Well done Year 6—you're awesome!

Today we've had a lovely visit from members of the Canadian RAF, who visit Sutton each May to commemorate the lives of hundreds of Canadian airmen who were based at the nearby RAF East Moor during the Second World War. Our Year 6 children showed our visitors round school and then led a PowerPoint presentation from research they have carried out about the Canadian RAF. All the children were very well-behaved and asked the visitors some thoughtful and intelligent questions.

Our Year 3/4 cricketers were victorious winners at their recent Cluster Kwik Cricket event held at Outwood Academy Easingwold. They played against three different schools and all of them played brilliantly. They will now progress to the final, which will be held at Sessay Cricket Club after half-term.
