Headteacher's Message

Welcome back to the last half term of this academic year - one that will be filled with lots of learning and fun.

On Monday, I attended a very interesting meeting in Leeds for SENCOs (Special Educational Needs Coordinators), which outlined a lot of the changes being made to special needs provision, both nationally and countywide. This will be the last of these networks that I will attend, as I am pleased to announce that Mrs Fineran will be taking on the role of SENCO in school from September. She begins her training at this end of this month and I know she will do a tremendous job leading on special needs provision in school.

You may be aware that each year, schools submit data to the Department of Education. This includes: assessments for children at the end of Early Years (all areas of learning), end of KS1 (reading, writing, Maths), and KS2 (writing). As part of this process, local authorities visit schools every few years to moderate teacher judgements, to ensure they are robust. This week our EYFS and KS2 judgements were moderated, and I am delighted to say that the feedback from both moderations was very positive and our judgements were deemed to be accurate. We are incredibly proud of our children and their achievements.

Practicing for the summer play has begun and all of our KS2 pupils have been given parts; it is already looking and sounding great and the children seem very excited. We are hoping to provide some costumes but it may be that we will require some from home. We will send home details of anything needed in the next couple of weeks.


We have welcomed Kai into school this week, and all of the children have made him very welcome. He has settled into Class 2 brilliantly and our children have been their usual welcoming selves.
