Headteacher's Message

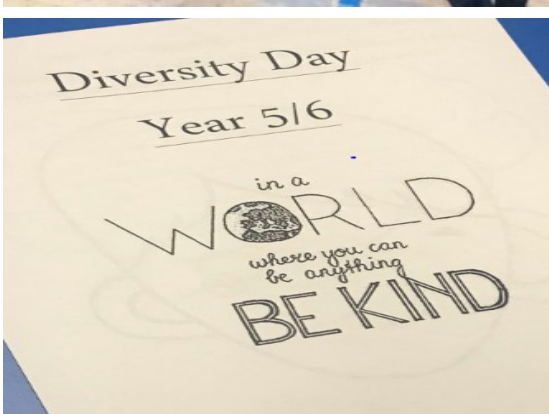
Welcome back to all of our families after half-term. After a miserable start to the week, we are hopefully starting to see signs of spring!
