As we begin the new academic year, I wanted to take this opportunity to remind you about our expectations regarding attendance and punctuality.

In September 2024, the Department for Education implemented updated guidance concerning school attendance. This sets out clear expectations that we must all follow. All pupils are required to attend school regularly, with absences only excused for valid reasons such as illness, medical appointments, or pre-approved exceptional circumstances. It is your responsibility as parents and carers to ensure your child attends school on time every day. Poor punctuality affects not only your child's attendance record but also the quality of their education.

As a school, we closely monitor attendance records throughout the year. If we notice any concerning patterns of absences, we will contact you to discuss the situation and work together to find solutions. Please remember that parents and carers are strongly discouraged from taking holidays during term time. The local authority may issue a Penalty Notice of up to £160 per child, per parent or carer for unauthorised term time leave. This applies when a child has 10 sessions of absence, which equals 5 school days, within a rolling period of 10 school weeks.

If you do need to request time off during term time, you must complete a term time absence form in advance. These forms are available on the school website or from the school office, and completing them is part of our safeguarding process. <u>Term time absence form</u>

We expect all parents and carers to ensure prompt attendance every day, with pupils arriving ready to participate in their classes. This is an 8.50am arrival, ready for a 9.00am start. Communication is key, so please notify the school immediately of any absences and provide the necessary documentation when required. Making this phone call ensures that you don't trigger the next stage of our attendance process.
